

Why use a Franchise Lawyer?



Franchise agreements can be complex and lengthy documents. If you become a franchisee this is the document which will form the basis of your relationship with the franchisor and which you will both “have to live with” for the term of the franchise agreement.

A franchise lawyer will:

- Help you understand both your legal obligations. A breach of the franchise agreement can have serious ramifications for you and it is essential that you understand exactly what you can and cannot do.
- Help you understand the franchisors’ rights and powers, so you know exactly what the Franchisor can and cannot do.
- Tell you whether or not what is in the franchise agreement is normal or not and whether it is reasonable or not.
- Be familiar with franchise agreements – you will not be paying for an inexperienced lawyer to come up to speed.
- Have connections in the franchise industry – they will be able to point you in the direction of other professionals who can assist you in making your decision whether or not to purchase a franchise.
- Not waste your time and money trying to negotiate a franchise agreement which for the most part is not negotiable

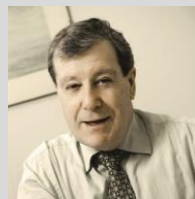
